into my father's Kven roots.**



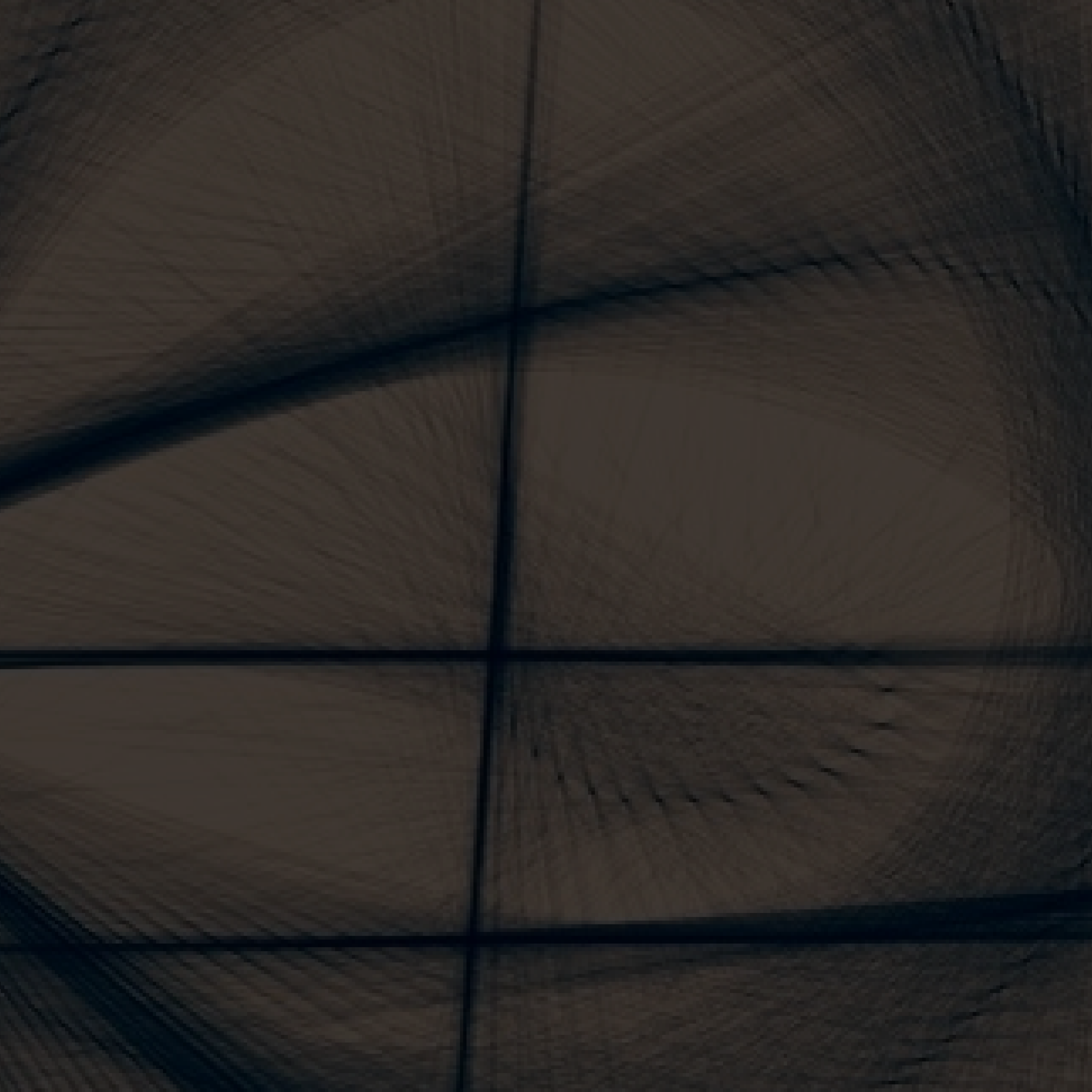
